OPEN ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Open Enrollment allows students to select up to 2 Specialty Programs. An electronic lottery occurs when there are more applicants than available seats.

If you get your 1st choice, you will **not** go into the lottery for your 2nd choice.

- If you do not get your 1st choice, you go into lottery for 2nd choice.

If you get your 2nd choice, you are **not** placed on a waitlist for your 1st choice.

- If you do not get your 2nd choice, you are placed on the waitlist for your 1st choice.

If you really only want one program, only choose 1 option.

To be entered into the lottery for any selected program, students must meet the required criteria, if there is a specified criteria.

To be invited to complete application assessments, students must first complete the general application.

- **The deadline to complete the general application is Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at 5:00 PM**
- Registered applicants will be emailed instructions to **their student email address** on how to participate in any required assessments or submit application portfolios on Wednesday, December 1st.

Students can be assessed for any of the three programs listed here. However, students can only apply to two programs.

The assessments will take place by invitation only. Students **MUST** have an application on file to be invited to complete assessments or submit portfolio.

Assessments will be administered both in person and via Zoom.
